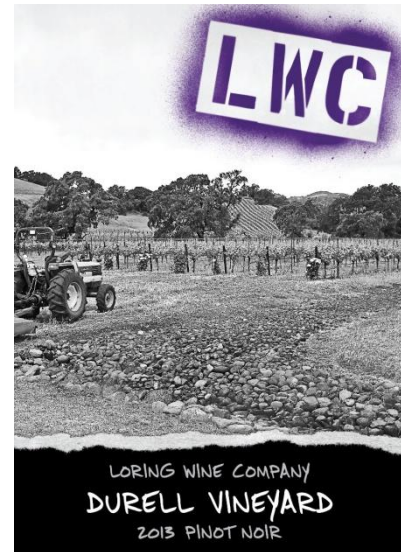




# Loring Wine Company 2013 Durell Vineyard Pinot Noir

Durell Vineyard is located in the Petaluma Gap region of the Sonoma Coast AVA. The area is actually quite warm - as such the fruit doesn't retain much acidity. The lower acid profile leads to the rounder, softer mouth feel that Durell Vineyard Pinots are known for.

## Winemaker Note

*Deep ruby color; earthy, forest floor aromas with some cherry notes; rich, deep cherry flavors with complex earthy notes, silky texture, good structure and balance; long finish. Complex Pinot with great texture.*
