

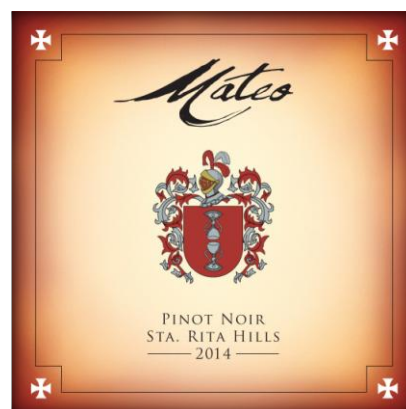

Bright ruby color with earthy plum and cherry aromas. Full, rich plum and cherry flavors with baking spice and white pepper notes. Amazing concentration and purity while still maintaining a very graceful and elegant mouth-feel. Perfectly balanced with a long, complex finish.
