About Les Vins Trouillet Lebeau

Ideally situated at the foot of the famous rock of Solutré, in the hamlet of Pouilly, is Les Vins Trouillet Lebeau. The estate was founded by Jean Guérin, who took over 4 hectares of share-cropped land from his father, Jules, and worked it for 45 years. Today the winery extends over 20 hectares and is owned and managed by Jean's grandson & 4th generation vintner William Trouillet, who is helped by his mother (and Jean's daughter) Marie-Agnès.

Vines are grown sustainably & in line with the requirements of the INAO (French agricultural regulatory organization). Tillage is largely carried out to encourage underground life and root development, so as to obtain the richness and minerality required for wines of great quality. The vines are planted on clay-limestone soil in 6 villages surrounding the domaine: Solutré-Pouilly, Fuissé, Loché, Vinzelles, Leynes, and Davayé.

About the Wine

This Pouilly-Fuissé is produced from 60 year old Chardonnay grapes (among the oldest of the domaine) that are grown in the foothills of the Solutre Rock on the parcel called "Chailloux" - the name means in old French clay and rounded "chailles" or stones. They play a significant role in the composition of the soil as they bring minerality to the wine.

The wine offers beautiful aromas of red juice orange and spices. Ample in the mouth, rich and full, with a fresh finish on citrus fruits.
