Origin	Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza.
Altitude	between 930 and 970 mts above sea level
Vine training	high vertical
Density	6,500 plants per hectare
Aging	aged for 10 months in French and American oak barrels of first and second use. Was conceived and created to be stored in bottle for more than 5 years, but can also be enjoyed now for its delicate concentration, balance and sweetness.

TASTING NOTES

Color	very intense, deep red, with purple tones. Its movement in the glass is elegant and with great density.
Nose	well balanced varietal characteristics, highlighting aromas associated with blackberries, strawberries and an elegant presence of oak that manifests itself as chocolate, tobacco, dulce de leche and vanilla.
Palate	very broad, with great volume and very consistent. Sweet entry, harmonious, with a long memorable finish. Longlasting red fruit confit flavors.
