Soil type	Clay & Limestone
Vinification	All the grapes were hand-harvested and then sorted and destemmed. The wine was vatted in wooden tanks for alcoholic fermentation. Once this fermentation and the corresponding maceration had been completed, it was racked to new French barrels for malolactic fermentation. In total, the wine remained in barrel for 48 months.
Pairings	Serve with red meats, roasts, or game dishes. Its flavor is enhanced with cured or fatty cheeses.
