<b>Appellation</b>	Chateauneuf du Pape AOC
<b>Wine Type</b>	Red
<b>Varietals</b>	80 years old Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre.
<b>Age of Vines</b>	Average 80 years
<b>Agricultural Practices</b>	Sustainable
<b>Soil type</b>	Sandy Soils
<b>Vinification</b>	The vineyard parcel selected for this wine is a single plot of 80-year old Grenache at the top of La Crau in Châteauneuf du Pape, the highest location in the AOC. It sits on a north-facing slope that helps guard against the sometimes intense summer heat that can affect the surrounding areas. This plot is called "Le Poteau" and has been generously granted to Todd Alexander by Anne-Charlotte as the core of this wine, with supplementation of Syrah and Mourvèdre from surrounding parcels also grown on the Château de la Font du Loup estate, to round out the blend. Aged for 18 months in neutral French Foudre.
