DESCRIPTION

Danko takes its name from the locally grown and malted Danko Rye that we use in this beer. Danko also happens to be the last name of the bass player for The Band, Rick Danko, who grew up near Simcoe Ontario. And guess what hop we use to dry hop this beer with? Yep, Simcoe! Now it all makes sense!

INGREDIENTS

Malt: American 2-Row Barley, Valley Malt Danko Rye, Vienna Malt, Valley Malt Amber Rye, Naked Oats, Flaked Barley

Hops: Simcoe, Simcoe Cryo, Cascade, Chinook

Yeast: House Ale Yeast

Tasting Notes:

Simcoe hops burst out of the glass with tangy peach, fresh figs and green plums. Balanced bitterness and earthy malt join in with Danko Rye for a light breadiness and smooth finish.
