Meursault, the world-renowned appellation, has produced mostly fine white wines for centuries.

Meursault Clos du Cromin takes its name from the village "Le Cromin", situated in the north-east of the appellation, close to the Volnay vineyard, in rich, clay soil.

The wine reveals a beautifully transparent and brilliant color, a subtle nose of citrus fruits, butter and honey, and a long finish.

Varietals	100% Chardonnay
Age of Vines	20-96 years old
Soil type	clay, limestone
Vinification	The grapes are pressed immediately without prior crushing. Following gentle pressing and some destemming, the must is placed in barrels. Ageing takes place in oak barrels, of which 25% are new, for about twelve months. This is followed by a few months in stainless steel vats to stabilize the wine before bottling.
Pairings	Pairs with a noble fish, or white meat in sauce.
