Pale yellow color with a green tinge. Elegant and subtle bouquet of citrus fruits and peach. Fruity and lively flavors of lemon, grapefruit and gooseberries. Fruit-driven with terroir expression, bright acidity and a long finish.

Varietals	75% Sauvignon Blanc, 25% Sauvignon Gris
Age of Vines	Average 30 years
Agricultural Practices	Sustainable
Soil type	Limestone from the Rupelian era, part of the Oligocene Age (32 million years ago) containing star fish, oysters and corral.
Vinification	Manual harvest; typically in September. Whole cluster direct press at low pressure with low amount of SO2, settling at 10 degrees Celcius. Addition of yeast and fermentation in 400-liter casks on the lees with regular stirring during 2 months. The wine is then aged 4 months in French oak barrels (between 15 and 20% new oak). Bottling in April of the following year.

Pairings	Fish, seafood, white meats, fine goat cheeses.
