

Chateau Brule Secaille Grande Reserve Cotes de Bourg Rouge

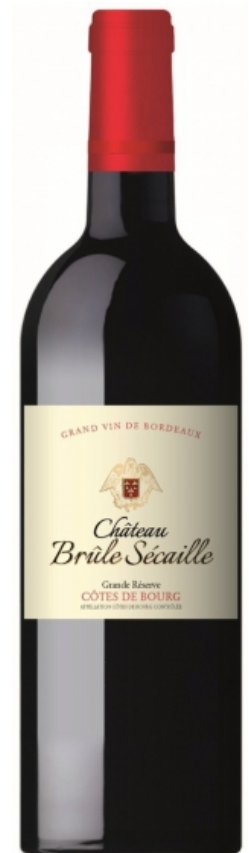

The color is deep dark ruby. limpid and brilliant. The nose is intense and complex with hints of blackberries, sweet spices, cedar and vanilla. The palate is full bodied, very long with well integrated tannins. The finish is very fresh and luscious with toasted notes in the background.

Pairings	Served with red meat (beef filet, sirloin), pork tenderloin, roasted duck breast with honey&orange sauce, roasted lamb with thyme, poultry and fine cheese.
