Merlot	79%
Cabernet-Sauvignon	17%

Average of vines	35 years
Terroir	Cby-limestone
Work in the vineyard	Double-guyot pruning. Careful budding for a cross ventilation, to provide great space for grapes development. Green harvesting for more clarity and a best concentration.
Harvest	Maximum attention is focused on the phenolic maturity for an excellent tannins/anthocyanins ratio and optimal sorting (grape by grape).
Vinification	Plot selection. Long maceration in small stainless steel tanks, with temperature control in order to obtain a good tannic structure. Punching down of individual grape varieties to preserve the finesse, the development of phenolic richness and the complexity of the terroir.
Ageing	Aging 18 months in French oak barrels.

Intensity and elegance  
An exceptional density combines with a deep garnet colour adorned with beautiful purple highlights. An intense and full nose conveys notes of mature black berries and subtle vanilla interlaced with coffee roasting soupçons. A beautiful structure, full in subtlety where the tannic density offers depth and length. The aromatic purity of each grape varieties absolutely matured is enhanced by the complex and elegant woody flavour impeccably controlled.
