Deep, intense ruby red, black fruit and cassis aromas, well-integrated woody notes, great structure and balance. Ripe and present tannins, elegant and sophisticated in the mouth, a pure expression of the terroir.

Vinification	Cool maceration for 6 days. Alcoholic fermentation for 6 days. Post fermentive maceration for 16 days. Aged 20 months in new French oak, and two years minimum in bottle prior to release.
