

## Imperial Stag Malbec Rose

### Imperial Stag Wines

#### Argentina - Mendoza - Lujan de Cuyo

The vineyards are planted on alluvial soil, mainly composed of sand, silt and gravel. This soil presents great permeability and a little proportion of organic material. It is irrigated by the Atuel river, that collects water from the Andes Mountains.

Imperial Stag Malbec rosé boasts a bright pale pink color, intense aromas of red fruits such as sour cherries and cherries with notes of red roses. On the palate, red fruit flavors and balanced acidity.

<b>Varietals</b>	100% Malbec
<b>Soil type</b>	Alluvial soil, mainly composed of sand, silt and gravel.
<b>Vinification</b>	Selection of clusters in the cellar. Short maceration with the skins. Alcoholic fermentation carried out in stainless steel tanks with controlled temperatures between 15°C and 18°C. Matured in tank for 6 months.
