

Lady Hill Willamette Valley Pinot Noir

A combo of garnet to cardinal highlights the hues of this fruit forward Willamette Valley Pinot Noir. Subtle floral hints of tea leaf and rose petal give way to a complexity of viney, brambled red and black fruit, wet moss and baking spices. A hint of savory jerky barrel nuance and turned earth contrast the freshness and vibrancy of boysenberry fruit. The finish is refined and juicy, as the elegant tannin structure builds into a crescendo of salivating acids built for food.

Wine Type	Red
Varietals	100% Pinot Noir
Age of Vines	Between 20 and 50 years old
Soil type	Jory and Willakenzie (marine sedimentary and clay)
Vinification	20% of the fruit comes from an old vineyard: Champoeg, planted on it's own rootstock and planted in 1974. The vines are still producing very concentrated fruit. Some of the wine was aged in new French Oak barrel and the rest was aged in 2-8 year used French Oak barrels for 12 months.
Production	225 (9-liter cases)
Pairings	Herb crusted pork loin, mushroom risotto drizzled with truffle oil, or a creamy textured Roucoulons cheese.
