

## Lima Vinho Verde Schist

### Encostas do Lima

### Portugal - Vinho Verde

This special project from the Adega Ponte de Lima highlights the diverse soils of the Vinho Verde region. Made from 100% Loureiro grapes, both the Granite and Schist varieties boast a crisp acidity and expressive minerality. The vineyards are 12.40 miles apart. Elevation is 70-190 meters above Sea Level (both locations), Slope at both locations 25-30 %.

Schist Soil and wine comes from the South Side of the Lima River (Northern Portugal).

Lima Schist Vinho Verde displays subtle yet more complex aromas. Full bodied, persistent and engaging.

<b>Soil type</b>	Schist
<b>Vinification</b>	Manual harvest. Fermented at 17°C (62°F) with the help of inoculated active dry yeasts ( <i>saccharomyces cerevisiae</i> ) that works the best with Vinho Verde. Stirring of the lees (batonnage). No oak. 7 grams per liter residual sugar (0.7%)
<b>Production</b>	500 (9-liter cases)
<b>Pairings</b>	Fatty fish, white meats and desserts.
