This Pinot Noir shows a light red color, aromas of roses and fresh fruits such as strawberry and cherry. The wine presents soft tannins and good acidity.

Specifications

Appellation	Leyda Valley
Varietals	100% Pinot Noir
Vinification	Pre-fermentative cold maceration for 5 days, with alcoholic fermentation occurring at 24-28 degrees C to better extract polyphenols from the wine. Post-fermentative maceration for 2 to 3 weeks then separation from the skins. Once the wine has been blended it is smoothly clarified. Aged in French oak barrels for 5-8 months.
Pairings	Salmon, light pasta dishes, and salads.
