<b>Varietals</b>	50% Malbec, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 20% Merlot
<b>Soil type</b>	calcareous gravel
<b>Vinification</b>	Aged 18 months in 70% French oak (Taransaud, Mistral, and Radoux), and 30% American oak. Aged additional 24 months in bottle prior to release.
