The wine is produced from vineyards located in the town of Orange, Sorgues, Courthezon and Chateauneuf-du-Pape. The soil is made of rolled pebbles, limestone, red clay, grey clay and sand.

Charles Thomas Chateauneuf-du-Pape rouge displays a deep garnet red color. On the nose it reveals a bouquet of small red berries and hints of spices. The palate is round, full and rich.

Varietals	60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Mourvedre, 10% Cinsault
Vinification	15 days fermentation in controlled temperature tanks. Light pressing and few months of aging (no oak).
Pairings	Game, duck, guinea fowl, pigeon, osso bucco, eggplant quiche and flavorful cheeses.
