Vinification	<p>Double Guyot pruning, debudding as well as green harvest to control the yields.</p> <p>Deleafing for a good aeration of the fruits, reducing humidity and keeping an eye on the ripening progress.</p> <p>Harvest at optimal maturity with systematic sorting of the grapes, during harvest and upon arrival at the cellar.</p> <p>Maceration for 3 to 4 weeks, depending of the vintage. Extraction of the color and tannins with (pigeage) punching downs and (remontage) pumping over. Everything is done at 26-28°C in temperature controlled vats in order to manage extraction.</p> <p>/> Ageing in thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks.</p> <p>/> Wine is racked before bottling.</p>

Pairings	Perfect with a magret de canard (duck breast) or a filet of beef.
