

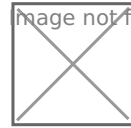
Hartl Pinot Noir Tattendorf Thermenregion DAC

Age of Vines	between 15 and 35 years old
Soil type	Barren alluvial soil (Ried Kräutergarten and Ried Graf Weingartl) + coarse alluvial material and little till (Ried Weinsatz)
Vinification	80% of the wine was aged in stainless steel tanks and 20% was aged in used Wooden casks.
Production	700 (9-liter cases)
Pairings	Handmade Pasta with game, boar or hare tomato sauce. Lasagna, Parmigiana, or a veggie pie. Also delicious with a grilled rack of lamb.
